In reference to the CCH 's letter no. 15-1/2019- CCH/162-165 dated 09.04.2019 wherein a Letter of Intent was issued to the **The Principal, Sangamner Medical Foundation Research institute's Vamanrao Ithape HMC & Hospital, Sangamner, Ahmednagar** to start Post Graduate Course of Study in the subject namely Psychiatry, Paediatrics and Repertory with 03 seats each the academic session 2019-20 subject to fulfillment of certain conditions, I am directed to say that after careful consideration of your proposal in terms of the provision of the HCC Act 1973, relevant regulations, inspection report of the CCH; permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to **The Principal, Sangamner Medical Foundation Research institute's Vamanrao Ithape HMC & Hospital, Sangamner, Ahmednagar to start Post Graduate Course of Study in the subject namely Psychiatry, Paediatrics and Repertory with 03 seats each for the academic session 2019-20** under the provision of the section 12A of the HCC Act 1973.

2. The college administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teaching faculty, non-teaching staff, hospital staff and other requirements as per the relevant CCH Regulations and Homoeopathy (Post Graduate Degree Course) M.D. (Hom.) Regulations, 1989 are in position before the admission of the first batch of students in above mentioned PG course is made, under intimation to the Central Government and CCH.

3. The College shall submit an undertaking in the form of an affidavit duly notarized within one month from the date of issue of this letter explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, Non-teaching staff of the College/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.



4. Further, the College shall submit an undertaking in the form of an Affidavit duly notarized to get permanent registration of the Teachers,/ Hospital Clinical Staff/ Consultant in concerned State Boards/ Council where the college/ hospital is located or Central Registration of CCH by 31st December, 2019 as per the decision conveyed vide CCH's letter no. 15-1/2018-CCH(3)/18510-18768, dated 16th January, 2019 and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant of permission for the A.Y. 2020-21.

5. It is further informed that 15% of undergraduate and 15% of post graduate seats of the permitted intake capacity shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats shall be conducted by the concerned State Government. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the concerned State Government to admit students as per their rules/ reservation policies/norms. **The permission of the college will stand withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the Central counseling for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

6. The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for above said PG courses well in time as per the CCH norms which will be verified and reported by the CCH at least three months before the start of next professional and accordingly, the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be issued.

7. The college administration may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under section 13(1) of the HCC Act, 1973 at that time when the first batch of students admitted against this course appears for the first final professional examination of the said course.
